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Body of missing Cullman kayaker found in northwest Alabama creek

FLORENCE, Alabama — Authorities have recovered the body of a kayaker missing in Cypress Creek in northwest Alabama.

Officials identified the kayaker as 22-year-old Daniel S. Smith of Cullman.

Emergency officials said his kayak overturned at a dam at the Florence water treatment plant on the creek around 4 p.m. Wednesday

Cypress Creek, a popular stream for kayaking and canoeing, was swift and muddy from heavy rain that fell Tuesday. The dam where the kayak overturned is downstream of Cox Creek Parkway.

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
